

Stamped Designs Dolphin Splash Class



Happy Birthday Card

1. Attach the navy dolphin piece to the medium blue card with wet glue or a dot tape runner so there is a slight border on the lower sides and bottom. Attach this combined piece to the front of the light blue card.
2. Start with the lighter gray extra pieces, attach the smaller dolphin pieces over the same section on the blue piece (not that the card in the picture has an error with the dorsal fin accidentally cut off – your piece will have the dorsal fin). Attach the tail pieces on the right in the same manner (2 pieces).
3. Attach the larger, darker gray dolphin to the blue piece in the same manner.
4. Layer the blue word piece to the light gray piece and then attach to the front of the card with a foam dot cut into 2 pieces.

Be the Change Card

1. Attach the light blue dolphin piece to the medium blue card with wet glue or a dot tape runner so there is a slight border on the lower sides and bottom. Attach this combined piece to the front of the white card.
2. Take the dark blue large dolphin and take a couple small pieces of regular tape and place them behind the openings for the “stripe” and the eye. Take the white stripe and white eye dot into the spaces – it will stick to the tape behind the openings. Attach this piece to the light blue piece with wet glue.
3. Attach the word piece to the upper part of the card with 3 small foam squares. Apply the white pearls as shown with wet glue.

Enjoy the Journey Card

1. Attach the medium blue dolphin piece to the dark blue card with wet glue or a dot tape runner so there is a slight border on the lower sides and bottom. Apply adhesive to the back and wrap the silver ric rac around the lower part of the piece and attach in the back of the card. Attach this combined piece to the front of the light blue card.
2. Attach the word circle piece to the lower part of the card with 2 small foam dots.
3. Attach the metallic silver dolphin piece to the blue piece with white glue. Note that the one in the photo has a slight cutting error – the lower part of the tail was cut off on my sample.
